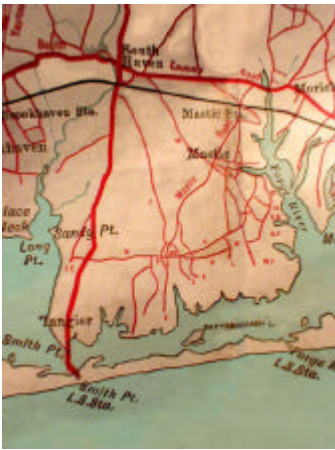
Historic Sites Committee: The Society's members have been conducting 'research workshops' at the community library in the Local History Room on Thursday nights at 7:00PM.
